Frequently Asked Questions

Are you handicapped accessible?

Yes, there is a chairlift at the west entrance into the house and an elevator for access to the second and third floors.

Who will set tables and chairs?

Our maintenance staff will set the tables and chairs in the house and courtyard.

Is there staff on-site during my event?

Yes, a receptionist will be on duty to open and then secure the building, offer directions to your guests and to help answer any questions you may have.

Where can we park?

Two-hour parking is available on Main and Oxford Streets. Unlimited, free parking is available on Monroe and Water Streets and one block south on Franklin Street. Car pooling is recommended for large groups.

What items are available for use?

TV/VCR/DVD, lecturns, and other A/V equipment may be available without a fee. LCD digital projectors, box mixer with speakers and microphones, both wireless handheld and lapel-style, are available at a cost, please inquire.

History of the Hayner Mansion

Built in 1914, the historic mansion that is now the Troy-Hayner Cultural Center was formerly the home of Mary Jane Harter Coleman Hayner.

The home was bequeathed to the Troy Board of Education upon the death of Mrs. Hayner in 1942 to be used for educational and/or cultural use.

The mansion was home to the Troy-Miami County Public Library from 1943 until 1976. That year, a new facility was built for the library and in December, 1976 the first open house was held at the newly remodeled Troy-Hayner Cultural Center.

The Center's philosophy is to enrich the lives of the citizens of our community regardless of age, race, religion, economic and/or handicapped condition through cultural pursuits. Exhibits, family days, antiques seminars, poetry readings, workshops and performing arts events are held at the Center regularly and are free and open to the public. Classes in art and other subjects are also offered.

Requests for weddings, receptions, parties, workshops, business meetings and seminars shall be accommodated when possible and when not in conflict with Troy-Hayner Cultural Center's previously scheduled activities. Reservations may be made up to one year in advance and rental fees may be applicable.
