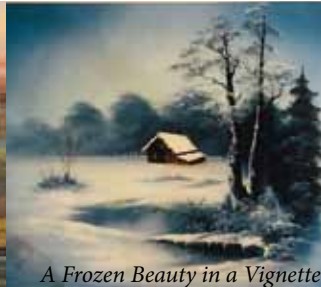

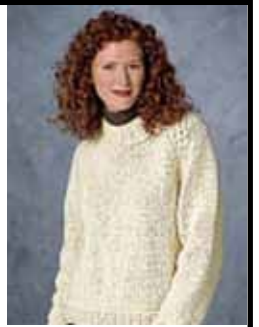

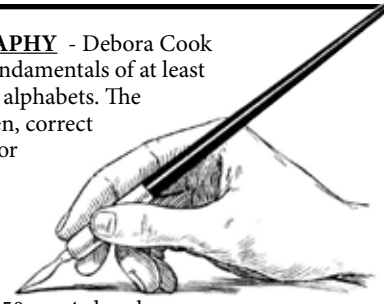


ETCHED GLASS CHRISTMAS ORNAMENTS - Debora Cook
