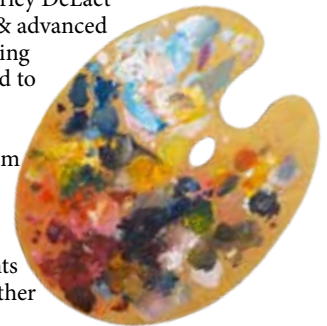
THE OIL PAINTER'S STUDY GROUP - Shirley DeLaet

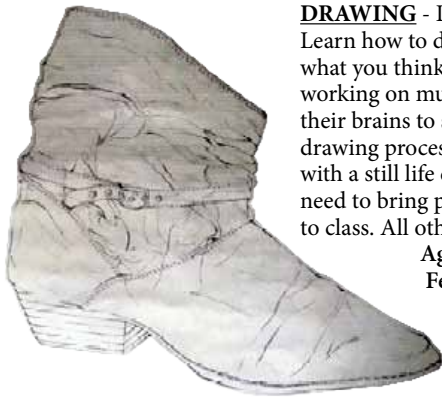
Come, paint with us! Traditional classroom instruction is replaced with heavy doses of encouragement and individual support from mentor, Shirley DeLaet.

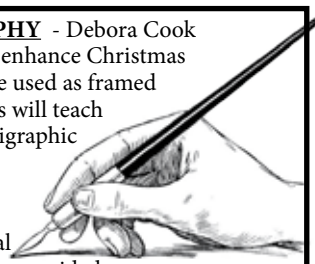

David Brand & Sandra Picciano-Brand We all have a stash of little treasures we've accumulated, or have had handed down to us over the years - buttons, coins, charms, badges, etc. This workshop will concentrate on incorporating them into jewelry designs by means of cold connection, i.e. mechanical means not involving soldering. These techniques include riveting, tabs, micro bolts, prongs, and others. You will also learn or brush up on the important metalsmithing skills of sawing, filing, drilling, as well as methods of surface embellishment.



Bring several items as not everything is suitable for mounting. We will also have elements available for use, much of it free, but also some for purchase. Suggestions for items to be set into your jewelry are: pottery shards, post cards, coins, buttons, charms, amulets, etc.

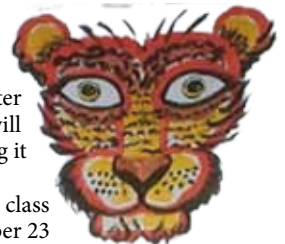

BALLET FOR GIRLS (2019 - 2020 SCHOOL YEAR)

Ballet Shreffler for girls is a continuous 2019-20 school-year program consisting of three 11-week terms (fall, winter, spring). Lessons are 75-minutes and meet once per week in the third-floor ballroom.

Dancers stay together as a class for the entire academic year.

Emphasis is placed on French terminology and technique, with each lesson building to the next. During the fall and winter terms, students begin learning dances for the Spring Ballet, which is performed at an area auditorium in late May. Class outfits are used as costumes. Please contact instructor for August fitting days for outfits and ballet slippers. (Leotard, tights, and skirt cost is approximately \$45 including soft slippers. Pointe shoe fitting will be held in October for girls age 11 or older with sufficient training.) Class fees are paid at the beginning of each 11-week term.

ACOUSTIC GUITAR FOR

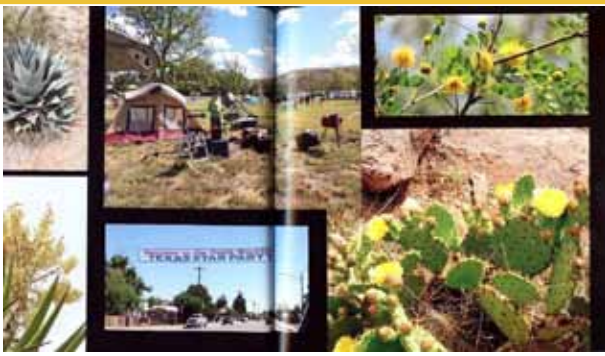
