- Using solvent and a paintbrush to create painterly effects
- Layering pencils for lifelike skin tones and transitions

- Knowing when to sharpen detail—and when to create soft edges

All students will receive a workshop document (workbook) with step-by-step guidance, tips, and follow-up instructions so you can confidently finish your portrait at home and use these skills in your future art pieces.




HOMESCHOOL ART (FRIDAY CLASSES) - Dana Leonard

BALLET FOR GIRLS (2025 - 2026 SCHOOL YEAR) - Cynthia Shreffler

1. Class meets once per week for 75 minutes in the Ballroom. Dancers learn French terminology and classic technique. Pre-K must be age 5 by March 15, 2026. Class fee for each 11-week term is \$60 (Cost for all 3 terms: \$180). Dancers stay together as a class through the academic year. A Spring Ballet performance with free admission is held at an area auditorium.

2. Ballet Shreffler for Girls forms in the fall term and continues through the academic year. There are three 11-week terms, fall, winter and spring. Each class group has an official outfit which is the costume for the Spring Ballet. Dancers are placed with their age group. During fall term, dancers form friendships, improve skills and learn new steps. Winter term begins work on choreography with each class group preparing three or more dances for our Spring Ballet. A dancer turning age eleven begins pointe if she has sufficient training. Dancers wear hair up in a ponytail or bun. Please choose a tote bag for ballet items. Pack a simple tee shirt or sweater. Fitting Days for the class outfit and ballet slippers are held by appointment at the instructor's home from August 11 - September 5, before the start of fall term. Please phone or text the instructor, Mrs. Shreffler, to make an appointment for fitting. (937) 974-8533

3. Cost of class: \$60 per each eleven-week term (fall, winter, spring). Class fees are paid directly to the Troy-Hayner Cultural Center. Make checks payable to Hayner Classes. Cash payments may be made in person at the Hayner Center. You can also register and pay at troyhayner.org/classes. Fees for each 11-week term are due before the first class for each term (due Sept. 5 for fall term).

4. Additional costs:

- · Leotard, skirt, tights and leather slippers ranges from \$50 \$65 with various items available at reimbursement (teacher's cost).
- · Pointe shoes for advanced dancers range from \$100 and up.
- •Toe pads for pointe shoes are approximately \$12.


