CHANGES TO THE HOME SCHOOL ART PROGRAM AT THE HAYNER - Please read carefully

- **Prepayment will be mandatory.** All payments will need to be made ahead of time either through Hayner PayPal, cash or a check mailed or dropped off to The Hayner. **All checks must be written to Troy Hayner Classes.** Refunds will not be given if a class is not attended.
- Once your payment has been received, you will choose a class date/dates and time by contacting Dawn Flory at 937-216-4999.
- In order to accommodate as many students as possible, each art class will consist of ALL AGES, kindergarten thru 12th grade. I know this seems like a very large range, but in holding class in this manner your child will be seated with their own siblings and this will allow for more students and less health concerns. Children will not be allowed to sit at a table with students from other families until restrictions from the health department are lessened. The students typically all learn the same lesson anyway. I normally provide aids to the younger students such as templates, or the older students might do a larger project or get to use more professional supplies. I feel completely confident that this can work, it's just going to be different & that's ok.
- If arriving early to class, please wait in your car. Five minutes before class starts, you may socially distance yourselves and wait in front of the art studio door for Mrs. Flory to

invite your student into the room (parents will not be allowed to enter the art studio at this time). Please do not come into the studio without being asked to come in.

- Students will exit at the door behind the fountain, parents may wait for their child across the drive under the tree. Students will not be allowed to leave the studio until a parent is visible.
- Please, do not block the Hayner Center driveway. Parents may park on the street or in the Hayner Center's parking lot on Water Street.
- Any socialization will need to be done outside of the Hayner building.
- Any child 10 years or older will need to wear a mask or some kind of face covering, unless they have a health condition restricting them from doing so. As soon as the health department relaxes this rule, we will too. Ms Flory will be wearing a face shield.
- All classes will cost \$10.00 per student, per lesson and will be for students of any age.
- Each class will be one hour long. Students will not be permitted to stay longer to finish if they do not get done. So very sorry.
- Class times... 9:30 - 10:30 10:45 - 11:45 12:00 - 1:00 1:15 - 2:15 (**Please note that class times have changed** and additional classes will be added if needed)
- Plastic table coverings will be changed after each class & chairs/tables will be sanitized.
- Children will need to stay seated during class unless they need to wash hands or use the bathroom.
- Your child may bring a bottle of water as the drinking fountain will not be shared.
- Classes will be held regardless of weather. There will NOT be cancellations or refunds.
