# DANCE

**BALLET FOR GIRLS (2022 - 2023 SCHOOL YEAR)** - Cynthia Shreffler  
 Ballet for girls pre-K (age 5 by 3/15/2023) through adult. Students learn classical technique and proper terminology in French. Classes meet once per week in the ballroom for 90-minutes. Classes begin in September and consist of three ten-week terms (fall, winter, and spring), plus an extra "tech-week" May 8-12. The academic year finishes with a performance held late-May or early-June on a full-sized stage in a school auditorium. Fitting days for outfits and ballet slippers are held by the instructor at her home from August 22 - September 10. Approximate reimbursement cost for complete outfit (leotard, tights, skirt, and leather slippers) is \$51 or less. Dancers may wear any leotard for class. The "official" outfit is also the costume for the Spring Ballet performance. Long student hair must be worn in a pony tail or bun. Headbands are not acceptable. Dancers age eleven and older, who have had sufficient training, may begin dancing on pointe. The instructor will fit dancers for pointe shoes as the need arises throughout the academic year. Pointe shoes and pads are at least \$100 with teacher's discount. Please phone the instructor to confirm proper class placement and to set up a fitting appointment and pick up outfit prior to the start of classes.

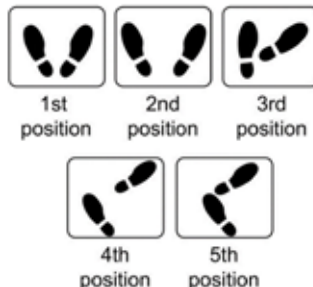
